 - a. Abstract and poster can be submitted together or separately.
 - b. Abstract submission is required for acceptance/event registration. Poster submission alone will not be accepted without an abstract submission.
 - c. Acceptance/Event Registration emails will <u>only</u> be sent to the email address of the Primary Author listed on the Abstract Submission Form. Acceptance Letters will include all authors listed on the project for purposes of tracking scholarly activity.
