Submission Guidelines

- **Abstract Submission Deadline = Sunday, December 15, 2019 11:59 p.m. – no exceptions**
 - Abstract Submission Link = <https://cuweb.wufoo.com/forms/qmhx6jr1xnnodl/>
 - This submission link is also located on the Home Page in New Innovations.
 - **This submission link will be deactivated after the submission deadline.**
 - Abstracts submitted via email will not be accepted. For any technical issues upon submission, contact Tydal Jackson, CUSOM GME Coordinator, at tmjackson@campbell.edu.
 - Abstract must be submitted before the poster – acceptance letters for the event will only be provided upon the submission of the abstract.
- **Poster Submission Deadline = Friday, January 10, 2020, 11:59 p.m. – no exceptions**
 - Submit poster as a PDF file to tmjackson@campbell.edu
 - Early poster submissions are strongly encouraged for early printing purposes. CUSOM will print all posters free of charge and hold them in a secure location until the night of the event.
- **Poster Size Requirement = 36" x 48"**

Participation Requirements

1. Participation at a PGY-1 level for a case presentation is required. Also, participation of either a case or IRB approved project or "work in progress" is required for the PGY 3+ terminal year of the program.
2. All sections of the Abstract Submission Form must be completed.
3. Poster must include a quality parameter (what you learned) and will be assigned to one of the 8 CMS categories.
4. Abstract and poster must include the attending physician mentor for the case/project.
5. The primary author for the case/project must be a resident.
6. Abstract and poster must include an osteopathic element related to either philosophy or treatment.
7. Groups cannot exceed the maximum number of 5 participants (including the required attending physician mentor and students where applicable). Not all members of the group need be present for the competition event in February.
