Submission Guidelines

- All abstracts and poster submissions must be submitted via email as <u>pdf documents</u>.
 - $\circ~$ Refer to 2018-2019 Abstract Submission Form for more details.
- Abstract and poster submissions may be submitted together or separately.
 - If submitted separately, <u>abstracts must be submitted first</u> to receive an acceptance letter.
- Early abstract submissions will prompt an early acceptance letter, with or without the poster.
 - Early poster submissions are also strongly encouraged due to printing time needed before the event.
- Hard deadline for <u>ALL</u> components will be <u>11:59pm, December 31, 2018</u> <u>no exceptions</u>.

Participation Requirements

- 1. <u>Participation at a PGY-1 level for a case presentation is required</u>. Also, <u>participation of either a case or IRB approved project or "work in progress" is required for the PGY 3+ terminal year of the program.</u>
- 2. Abstract must be submitted on the 2018-2019 Abstract Submission Form (please see your Program Coordinator for a copy or refer to the homepage in New Innovations).
- 3. All sections of the Abstract Form must be completed.
- 4. Poster must include a quality parameter (what you learned) and will be assigned to one of the 7 CMS categories.
- 5. Abstract and poster must include the mentoring attending physician for the case/project.
- 6. Abstract and poster must include an osteopathic element related to either philosophy or treatment.
- 7. Groups may consist of up to 4 residents (to include students where applicable), and an attending physician mentor. Not all members of the group need be present for the competition event in February.
